WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION:

Course Objectives

This one-day workshop is designed for learners to develop a working knowledge of watermain disinfection principles, flushing, testing and dechlorination procedures related to new watermain installations, upgrades and emergency repairs.

Key concepts are addressed in the context of industry standards geared to facilitate upgrades to the distribution system and new main installation. The procedures dealt with are designed to ensure that installations and upgrading are successfully achieved while safeguarding water quality and the environment.
