I have been involved in the development of corrosion control programs in Atlantic Canada since 1998 and on permanganate applications in drinking water treatment for taste and odor control, iron and manganese oxidation, pre-oxidation replacing pre-chlorination to reduce disinfection-by-products formed during that treatment in Canada, Latin America, and Europe. I have been a member of the AWWA and WEF since 1990. In 1998, I was appointed Managing Director for Canada & Latin America, prior to that I was District Manager in New York and New Jersey and then Regional Manager for West/Southeast USA for Carus.
