## **CCC Surveyors Course Content**

The CCC Surveyor course of instruction shall be for a minimum duration of 24 hours, following an outline similar to that provided below:

### **Topics to be Covered**

- proper device application
- hazard classification
- premise vs. internal protection
- zone/area protection
- plumbing code requirements
- provincial CCC regulations
- municipal CCC by-laws
- building survey (field trip)
- plan review
- survey report form
- record keeping
- responsibilities and liabilities
- etiquette and protocol
- communication skills
- review and examination

### **Objectives**

The student will learn:

- the intent of the program
- history of the program
- legal and health aspects
- surveyor/tester responsibilities

### **Text and References**

Each students must have a copy of the following documents:

- Canadian AWWA Cross Connection Control Manual, latest edition
- CSA B64.10-01, latest edition

### **Exercises**

- A survey of an existing building will be completed

## **Teaching Aids**

- manufacturers literature
- CCC devices
- photos of cross connections

## **Examination**

At the conclusion of the course of instruction, the student may challenge the ACWWA CCC Surveyor Written Examination.

## **Prerequisite for Certification**

- Must be a Certified AWWA CCC Tester
- Journeyman Plumber or equal with 5 years related experience in the plumbing field

## **Certification**

A performance of 80% minimum on the written examination and successful completion of a supervised building survey constitutes a passing mark and a Certificate of Achievement will be issued by ACWWA. A Certificate of Attendance will be issued to those completing the course but not meeting the above requirements.
