Course Objective / Description:

While regulatory examples may reference Ontario standards, the core principles apply to professionals in various regions.

- Overview of pressurized equipment and their applications
- Safety measures, emergency preparedness, and risk mitigation
- Industry best practices for compliance and workplace safety
- Best practices for maintaining and operating pressurized equipment

This course is designed for water and wastewater professionals responsible for operating and maintaining pressurized systems, ensuring safe and efficient facility operations.
